參賽須知:

- 1. 参加者須按年級報參賽組別。
- 2. 參賽者必須完成五個指定比賽項目。
- 3. 如參賽者未能完成所有項目,大會可決定取消其參賽資格。
- 4. 所有繳費費用將不獲發還。
- 5. 大會將保留最終決定權及章程修改權利。
- 6. 成功報名的參加者會被視作同意大會於比賽時拍照,並同意本學院使用其照片日後作宣傳或其他用途。





比賽項目:

- 参加者必須完成五個項目: (A) 遠距離賽、(B) 高抛球賽、(C) 切桿賽、(D) 推桿賽及(E) 沙坑賽。
- 所有年齡組別最高得分為 120 分

A. 目標距離賽 (50 分)

- 參賽者向 2 個目標發球 5 次,每球落在目標範圍以內可獲 5 分
- 不同年齡需要打的距離都不一樣,每個球手可自由選擇任何球桿以打中目標。

B. 高抛球賽 (20 分)

● 參賽者須一桿把球由指定的果嶺位置而前面設有障礙及打入指定的目標洞內·每人可發球 5 次。能 一桿把球打入目標範圍內·可得 4 分。

C. 切桿賽 (15 分)

● 參賽者須一桿把球由指定的果嶺位置打入指定的目標洞內,每人可發球 3 次。能一桿把球打入目標內,可得 5 分。如未能切入,則按其距離球洞來決定分數。

E. 沙坑賽 (15 分)

参賽者須把球由指定的沙坑位置而打入指定的目標洞範圍內,即可得分。每人可發球5次,每次可得3分。





比賽規則:

- 1. 參賽者須於大會編定的第一項比賽時間前 15 分鐘向工作人員報到。報到時須出示有效的身份 證明文件,以供核對姓名。若參賽者未能提供身份證明,大會有權取消其參賽資格。
- 2. 參賽者須按大會編定的各項比賽時間到達比賽場地·並向大會幹事報到·凡逾比賽時間 5 分鐘 仍未能報到者·均作自動棄權論。
- 3. 參賽者須遵守南華體育會,澳洲高爾夫球學院及大會有關的使用守則。
- 4. 比賽進行期間,參賽者須在指定時間內完成各項賽事。
- 5. 當參賽者進入比賽場地後,一律禁止接受任何人「指導」。「指導」是指任何可能影響參賽者 判斷,例如選用球桿、目標線對齊或擊球方法的提示等。
- 6. 非參賽者不得進入比賽範圍,以免對參賽者造成滋擾。
- 7. 比賽進行期間,任何人士均須保持安靜。
- 8. 參賽者在各項正式比賽中,不設賽前試發球。
- 9. 如參賽者在準備揮桿前的預備球被自己的球桿意外移動,該球即計算為「比賽球」;參賽者比賽時如打「空桿」 (air-shot),該球亦當作「比賽球」計算。
- 10. 除本章程明文規定外,其他賽規一概依據「蘇格蘭聖安德魯斯皇家古代高爾夫球俱樂部」及「美國高爾夫球協會」的現行比賽規則。
- 11. 大會不設上訴,一切賽果以當場裁判的判決為準。
- 12. 如參賽者違反規則或有不良行為而影響賽事,大會有權取消其比賽資格。所有已繳費用將不獲 發還,其所得的比賽成績亦一律作廢。
- 13. 參賽者須負責個人財物的安全。

裁 判: 所有比賽項目由澳洲高爾夫球學院教練擔任裁判。

改 期: 如天文台於比賽當日早上 7 時已發出 3 號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號或紅色暴雨警告信號,當日的比賽即告取消。比賽將會擇日重賽,恕不另行通知。詳情可在澳洲高爾夫球網址www.juniorgolf.com.hk 公告。請各參賽者留意賽事改期的安排及準時出席比賽,恕不退款。

Hong Kong Junior Golf Driving Range Competition 2024 Rules and Details

Date: 24 Aug 2024 (Sat) Time: 10:00 – 12:00

Report Time: 09:30 on 24 Aug 2024 Eligibility: Age under 14 years old

Grouping: 3 groups according to their year of birth

U8 (Born after 2016)

U11 (Born between 2013 – 2015)
 U14 (Born between 2010 - 2012)

Competition Items:

- 1. Putting
- 2. Chipping
- 3. Pitching
- 4. Bunker
- 5. Long Distance Accuracy (BULL-EYE)

Awards:

- There is a champion, First Runner Up, and Second Runner Up in each year's group
- Every participant who has completed the competition will be awarded a certificate

No of Participants: 150 people (First Come First Serve)

Fee:

HK\$200 - SCAA Members or students from AGA

HK\$250 - Non-SCAA Member or non-student from AGA

Remarks:

- 1. All participants are required to register according to their age group.
- 2. Participants need to complete all 5 items
- 3. If the participant failed to complete all the items, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify them
- 4. All competition fees are non-refundable or non-transferable.
- 5. The organizer reserves the right to make final decisions and to modify the regulations
- Participants who successfully register will be considered to consent to the committee taking photographs during the competition and agree to the college's use of their photos for promotional or other purposes in the future





Details of Competition Items:

- Participants must complete five events: (A) Long-distance race, (B) Pitching; (C) Chipping; (D) Putting
 & (E) Bunker Shots
- The maximum score for all age groups is 120 points.

A. Long Distance Race (50 points)

- Each participant will be assigned 2 targets and has 5 chances to shoot toward each target.
- For each ball landed within the target range can score 5 points
- The distance will vary according to age grouping. Participants can decide to use which club to shoot the ball.
- The distance between the target is as below:

	U8	U10	U14
1 st Target	50 yrds	75 yrds	75 yrds
2 nd Target	100 yrds	100 yrds	150 yrds

B. Pitching (20 Points)

- Participants must, within a single stroke, hit the ball from the designated position, towards the assigned target.
- Each person will have 5 shoots
- If the participant can hit the ball into the target with one (1) shot, can score 4 points

C. Chipping (15 Points)

- Participants must, within a single stroke, hit the ball from the designated position, towards the assigned target.
- Each person will have 3 shots
- If the participant can hit the ball into the target with one (1) shot, can score 5 points. Otherwise, can score points according to the distance away from the target

E. Putting (20 Points)

- Two Parts Short Putt and Long Putt
- For Short Putt, participants have 4 chances to putt the ball into the target with one (1) shot. Each successful shot can score 2 points
- For Long Putt, participants have 4 chances to putt the ball into the target with one (1) shot. The highest score will be 4 points

F. Bunker (15 Points)

- Participants must hit the ball from the designated position into the assigned hole range to score points.
- Each participant will have 5 shots, each successful shot can score 3 points.





Terms and Conditions:

- Participants must check in 15 minutes before the first scheduled competition time set by the organizer.
 Identification documents must be presented at check-in for verification. Anyone who fail to provide identification may be disqualified.
- 2. Participants are required to report to the staff for each competition item on their own. Anyone who fails to report will be considered to have forfeited automatically.
- 3. Participants must adhere to the rules of the South China Sports Association, the Australian Golf Academy (AGA), and the regulations set by the organizer.
- 4. During the competition, participants must complete each item within the specified time.
- 5. Once participants enter the competition venue, they are strictly prohibited from receiving any form of "coaching" from anyone. "Coaching" includes any form of advice that could influence a participant's judgment, such as suggestions on club selection, aligning target lines, or hitting techniques.
- 6. To prevent disruptions to participants, individuals who are not competing are prohibited from entering the competition area.
- 7. During the competition, all individuals are required to maintain silence.
- 8. Prior to the official competitions, participants are prohibited from taking practice shots.
- 9. If a participant inadvertently displaces their preparatory shot with their club before swinging, the ball will be considered a "played ball." Similarly, if a participant executes an "air shot" during the competition, it will also be classified as a "played ball."
- 10. Besides the regulations explicitly stated in this document, all other rules will be based on the current competition rules of the "Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews" and the "United States Golf Association."
- 11. The committee does not entertain appeals, and all rulings made by the on-site referee are conclusive.
- 12. Should a participant breach the rules or conduct themselves in a manner that impacts the competition, the organizer retains the authority to disqualify them. All fees paid will not be refunded, and any competition results obtained will be voided.
- 13. Participants are responsible for their own personal belongings.

Referee: All competition events will be officiated by coaches from the Australian Golf Academy

Terms to postpone the competition:

If the Hong Kong Observatory issues a Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above, or a Red Rainstorm Warning Signal before 7:00 AM on the day of the competition, the event will be cancelled. The competition will be rescheduled for a later date without further notice. For more information, please refer to the website at www.golfaga.com. Participants are advised to take note of the rescheduled event and attend punctually. No refunds will be provided.
